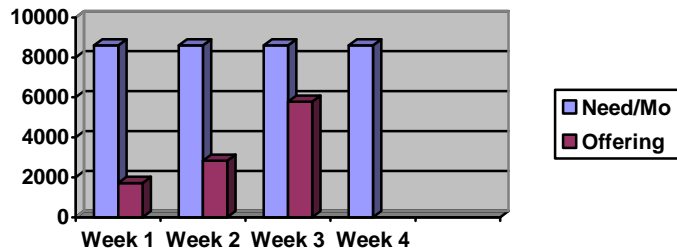
THE FLORAL ARRANGEMENT in the sanctuary today is a love offering to God from Frank & Elvia Spurgeon in celebration of their anniversary.

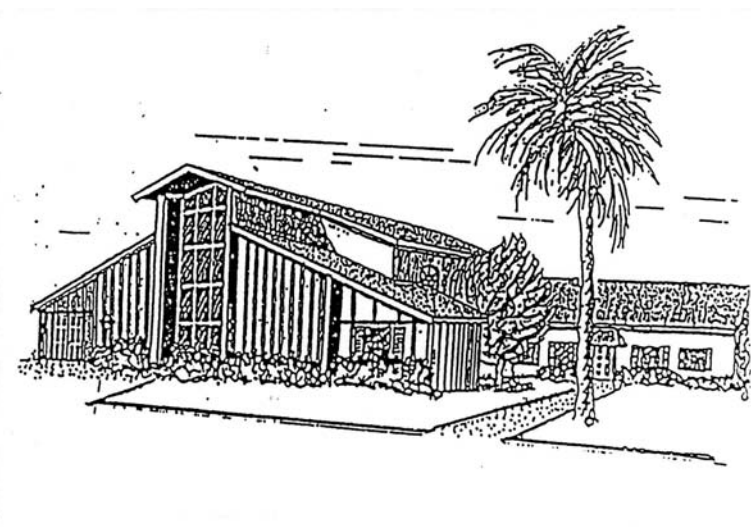
