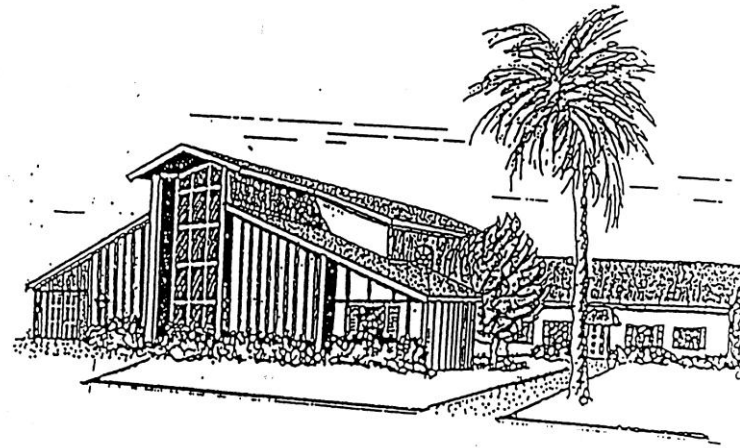
PATHFINDERS are on their annual river trip this weekend. Let's keep them in our prayers.

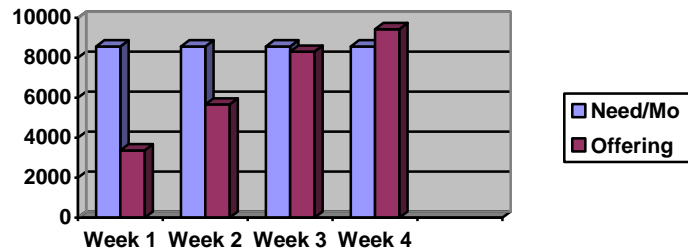
