THE FLORAL ARRANGEMENT in the Sanctuary today is a love offering to God from the Garcia's in celebration of Aldie's birthday.

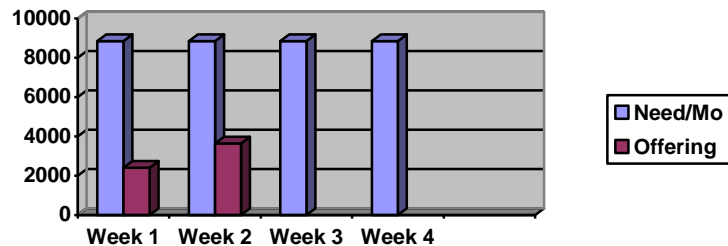

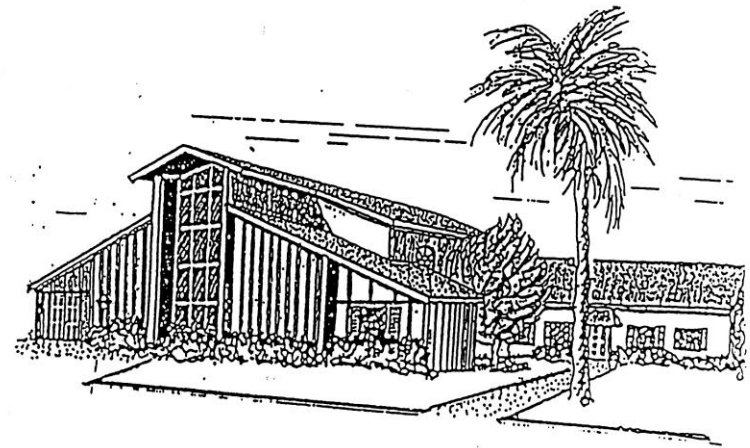

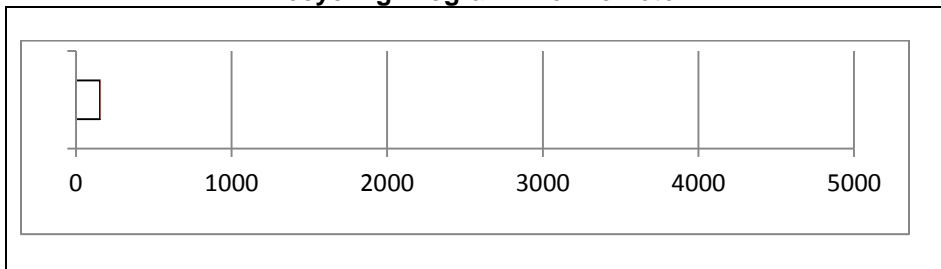
